CSJ Promotes Japanese FDI in U.S. Healthcare Sector; Aug. 4 - 5: Specialist Hanawa and CS Western Japan organized two SCP seminars--one at the Embassy in Tokyo and another at the U.S. Consulate-General in Osaka--for client Globizz, a California based regulatory consulting firm. A/SCO Taevs and CO Mayeda kicked off their respective events.
