



- The casket of late-Prime Minister Obuchi's ashes is brought into the hall and placed on the central altar.
- The Imperial Family, followed by the Envoy of T.M. The Emperor and The Empress, enters the hall and takes their seats.
- Opening Remarks are given by the Chief Cabinet Secretary and Vice-Chairman of the Memorial Service Committee.
- The Guard of Honour enters.
- Silent Prayer is offered.
- The Guard of Honour leaves and the recorded figure of late-Prime Minister Obuchi is put on the air for five minutes.
- Condolences expressed by Chairman of the Memorial Service Committee.
- Condolences expressed by Chairman of House of the Representatives.
- Condolences expressed by Chairman of the House of Councillors.
- Condolences expressed by Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.
- Condolences expressed by Friend TBD of late-Prime Minister Obuchi.
- Memorial Music is performed.
- The Envoy of T.M. The Emperor and The Empress proceeds to altar, pays homage to late-Prime Minister Obuchi, and leaves.
- Flowers are laid by the Imperial Family, Japanese Officials, and Others.
- The President, accompanied by U.S. Delegation, proceeds up center aisle, pauses for a moment, places a flower on the altar, backs away from the altar and pauses, and then departs.






